

Tournament Regulations

1. **All competitors** must be affiliated to the ITTA Ltd or to an association affiliated to the ITTF.
2. **Matches will** be played in accordance with the current rules and regulations of the ITTA Ltd.
3. **The tournament committee** reserves the right to alter the programme, format or venue; to cancel any event; to reject and regrade entries; and to restrict admission to the tournament venue.
4. **Players will** be scratched if not present and ready to play when called on.
5. **The decision** of the Umpire on facts and of the Referee on points of law is final and binding.
6. **Umpiring:** All players may be called on to umpire. Players who do not umpire when requested will be liable to be scratched from the tournament.
7. **Bats must** have a combination of approved red and black rubber. Players must have access to a reserve bat, which must also comply with I.T.T.F. regulations.
8. **Players must wear** rubber-soled shoes and proper dress and **white clothes are not allowed.**
9. **Format of Events:** All singles events will be played on a Round Robin format, providing table time permits.
10. **Gluing** can only take place outside of the building.
11. **Event entry restrictions:** Players are restricted to a maximum of two singles events **Class 2** - Closed to men ranked in the Top 20 in Ireland, (senior internationals senior inter pro's – within the last 5 years) and also to the top 8 seeded players in the men's open singles on the day of the tournament or equivalent standard as decided by the committee.
Under 21 – Open to male & female players. Must be under 21 on 31/12/2009
Veterans – must be 40 years old before 31/12/2009.
12. **Acceptance of these regulations is a condition of entry.**
